The Art Therapist will be responsible for both direct service delivery and program coordination. This includes planning and facilitating individual and group therapy sessions and evaluating client progress. The Art Therapist will also support program development and expansion initiatives as needed.

The ideal candidate will have experience working with children, youth, and adults in multicultural and low-income settings, and demonstrate strong skills in communication, counseling, program management, and evaluation. A deep understanding of visual art, along with a commitment to staying current with best practices and emerging trends in art therapy, is essential.

- Develop, coordinate, and facilitate individual and group art therapy sessions for youth, seniors, individuals, and families
- Utilize art-based and psychotherapeutic techniques to support clients' emotional, cognitive, and physical well-being

- Document, and evaluate client behaviors, progress, and outcomes during therapy sessions
- Develop, implement, and track program evaluations; analyze data and report on overall program effectiveness
- Promote Therapeutic Programs and create partnerships with organizations, government entities, and schools to foster partnerships
- Lead Thrive Studio volunteer engagement
- Manage Art Therapy supplies, materials, equipment and track inventory
- Coordinate and facilitate a weekly senior women's program, including group scheduling
- Support program development and expansion initiatives as needed
- Develop and train staff and volunteers as needed
- Assist with managing disruptions as needed
- May serve as a master trainer for crisis intervention, multicultural mental health counseling and trauma-informed care training
